Re: FBI raid on Patriot Network on May 3, 2007

Dear Agent Andy:

I sent you some letters earlier but you have refused to respond to any of them. Please return to me the items you have seized from me that have no use for in your investigation. This includes my stationary, my hand-outs, political literature, flyers, copies of the Constitution, inventory of the Patriot bookstore, etc.

I am doing some research for you. The term "debt elimination" means fighting credit cards and credit repair to the folks in this area. However, to the folks in Asheville and further west, as I have just discovered, that terms stands for bank instruments.

According to some forms released under the FOIA- PA from your headquarters in Washington, your Form FD-515 "DISRUPTION OR DISMANTLING OF AN ORGANIZATION" can be used for suppressing criminal gangs, organized crime and urban youth gangs- not political organizations. The Patriot Network is definitely a political organization and nothing else.

Your FBI agents seized the Patriot Network inventory of books and videos to harass and burden a political organization. You had no legitimate law enforcement purpose for the search warrant. Your agency wanted to destroy a political organization that the FBI has determined was wrong. However, you have no authority under the law or regulations, either to make such a determination or to attack political organizations. The Patriot Network is protected by the First, Ninth and Tenth Amendments of the US Constitution.

As you know, the case in Greenville is over. The Judge issued an injunction against me that halted me from doing those activities which the court determined were incorrect. Since the federal judge has made a determination, the FBI does not need to make one. Apparently the FBI feels that the federal judges are incompetent and do not know how to carry out their lawful functions.

Those activities which you disagree with were subject to the DOJ's original petition for injunction against the PN. However, the DOJ withdrew most of their objections to my activities. Your agency is attacking me for the same activities that the government attorneys did not considered wrongful. Apparently the FBI also feels that the DOJ Attorneys are incompetent and do not know how to carry out their functions.

Incidentally, the federal Judge and the Department of Justice have statutory authority from Congress to enjoin business organizations dealing with taxes. The FBI has no authority whatsoever for their action against me.

As your people have probably told you, this case is headed toward litigation. Your actions will soon be scrutinized by the federal judiciary. Also, I have a right for damages under the Privacy Act, the Civil Rights Act, etc. If you desire to resolve this case administratively, return my property and have your attorney contact me.

As you saw in the news-media, the FBI in Boston just paid out over one million dollars in damages, plus receiving adverse publicity.

Enclosed is a copy of a cartoon and copies of US Dollars used as a religious track by some church organization. Please go arrest those folks!
